AWARDING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT TO THE DANE COUNTY  
WISCONSIN PROFESSIONAL POLICE ASSOCIATION SUPERVISORY LAW ENFORCEMENT  
UNIT

The County has reached a tentative agreement with the Dane County Wisconsin Professional Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit on a collective bargaining agreement that will run from December 17, 2023 through December 14, 2024. The current collective bargaining agreement will run through December 16, 2023. The County employs approximately 46 full time equivalent employees in this bargaining unit.

The agreed upon principle economic items include increases to the wages, undesirable hours pay, weekend/holiday OIC assignments, and temporary reassignment. An increase in floating holiday hours, increases in maximum amount for the sick bank, increase in bereavement leave hours, stillbirth policy, an increase of retirement enhancement money, and additional vacation after 26 years of service. All negotiated changes are highlighted in the attached summary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors approves the cost of living adjustments between Dane County and the Dane County Wisconsin Professional Police Association Supervisory Law Enforcement Unit for the period of December 17, 2023 through December 14, 2024; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that County officials take appropriate action to implement this resolution.
