DANE COUNTY OPIOID SETTLEMENT

Background

- County Board authorized Corp Counsel to retain outside counsel to join nationwide litigation against Opioid Manufacturers, Distributors and Retailers
- The law firm of Baron & Budd was a member of the consortium of law firms representing local governments nationwide.
- Dane County filed a lawsuit in the Western District Court of Wisconsin in June 2018; Case was consolidated in the MDL in the US District Court of Ohio

- Litigation has led to 2 "Global" Settlements
 - In 2022, the County Board approved joining a settlement with 4 defendants
 - Three Major Distributors: Amerisource Bergen, Cardinal Health & McKesson
 - 1 Manufacturer: Jansen (aka Johnson & Johnson)
- In 2023, the County Board approved joining a settlement with 5 other defendants
 - Two Manufacturers: Teva and Allergen
 - Three Retailers: Walmart, Walgreens and CVS

- Allocation Formula for Settlement Dollars in WI
 - In 2021, the Legislature adopted Wis. Stat. §165.12 that controls allocation.
 - 70% of funds allocated to Wisconsin to litigating local governments
 - ✤30% to the State
 - Share to Local Governments is allocated per a MOU
 Dane County receives 8.248% of the WI Local Government Allocation.

- 2022 First Settlement: Janssen & 3 Distributors
 - Distributors are to pay a total of \$21 billion over 18 years to all litigating entities
 - Jansen is to pay \$5 billion over no more than 9 years to all litigating entities
- Total Wisconsin Allocation is \$402,168,925
- ✤ Dane County share is \$23,220,547

- ✤ Total: \$3,897,182
 - Received more than anticipated in 2022 due to "front loading" of Janssen payments.
 - Distributor Payment 3 of \$676,491.72 allocated and expected to be received by Mid-July, 2023.

- Second Settlements: 2 Manus. & 3 Retailers
 - Defendants will pay \$18.76 billion over 14 years.
 - Teva up to \$3.34 billion over 13 years
 - ✤ Allergan \$2.02 billion over 7 years
 - CVS \$4.9 billion over 10 years
 - ✤Walgreens \$5.52 billion over 15 years
 - ✤Walmart \$2.74 billion within 6 years.
 - Final Allocation will be based on the number of participating States and Local Governments
 That is being calculated now. Too early for real #s
 - Should have more information within 60 days or so.
 - Payments may start in the 4th Qtr. (But cannot be confirmed)

- Other Defendants
 - Dane County still has claims against several defendants
 - Some have filed for bankruptcy.
 - Future settlements with some likely.
