**SUGGESTED ADDITIONS:**

- Support fair retention of real estate transfer fees to counties.
  - This was passed as a resolution in 2022 but never added to the agenda.
- Engage on emerging legislative issues and administrative rules that directly affect county operations, finances, or services, provided positions remain consistent with Dane County’s principles of local control and effective service delivery.
  - Allows for additional flexibility if an issue arises that a department flags as having an adverse effect. For instance, there was legislation that would have allowed for a new system to transfer incapacitated patients from a hospital to another facility without a formal guardianship proceeding and made county corp counsels the keeper of the records of the new form. There may be instances where even if we are not taking an up or down position on a bill, we may want to provide input on the details of how it is drafted
