Brown reviewed the 2021-2025 ride trends graph with the commission members.

Brown said the Wisconsin Dept of Health Services put out a RFP to provide non-emergency medical transportation to medicaid consumers. The intend to award the contract to Veridia Inc. There is no timeline yet for the service to transition over.

Brown announced the AAA Board and ADRC Board are co-hosting a meet and greet with Dane County Legislators on June 17. Brown will send out more information to the commission on this.

Brown requested that the STC meeting in July be moved to July 15 so he can get the 5310 application approved.

### 2. Updates from Greater Madison Metropolitan Planning Organization - Ben Lyman

Lyman mentioned the 5310 applications will be released the week of June 8. Lyman said the policy board did adopt the active transportation plan for Dane County including the emoto guidance for communities classifying them as motorcycles and not ebikes.
