MOTION ORDERING A 2025 SPECIAL ELECTION FOR DANE COUNTY SUPERVISOR –  
DISTRICT 1

The Dane County Board of Supervisors hereby orders that a special election be held for the office of Dane County Supervisor – District 1.

District 1 was made vacant on March 31, 2025, by Supervisor Elizabeth Doyle.

The duly elected supervisor shall serve for the remainder of the term ending on April 21, 2026.

The special election will be held on Tuesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025. If there are three or more candidates, a special primary will be held on Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Nomination papers for this office may be circulated beginning Friday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025, and the deadline for filing nomination papers is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2025. Candidates are required to gather a minimum of 50 and a maximum of 200 valid signatures.

District 1 encompasses wards 45, 47, and 51-55 in downtown Madison
