

2025 RES-338
SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR SHERIFF AND
CLERK OF COURTS

State Statute requires the County Board to establish annual compensation for elected officials before the earliest time for filing nomination papers for elective office. County Board rules also require the Personnel and Finance Committee to make recommendations on compensation levels by March 15 of even numbered years. Consideration of a resolution setting salary adjustments is one approach to making that recommendation. Nomination papers for the offices of Clerk of Courts and Sheriff will be filed in 2026. Compensation for these offices must be set prospectively and cannot be changed during the term of office.

The current salary for the Clerk of Courts is \$132,184, and the current salary for the Sheriff is \$168,050.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the salaries for the offices of Clerk of Courts and Sheriff be established as follows:

Clerk of Courts	\$133,505	\$134,841	\$136,189	\$137,551
Sheriff	\$169,731	\$171,428	\$173,142	\$174,874

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the 2027 salary shall become effective on the date the officials are sworn in to office.
