Hospital Signatures - Carrie Meier

Meriter staff has brought up concerns about EMS asking for last name of nurse or doctor that care is being handed off to. Meier followed up with Dane County Corp Counsel to review. It's not just about billing, it's about the transition of patient care. Requirement is just first letter of first name and last name. Educate hospitals on why this is being asked. Sellek from Middleton summarized why getting the name is required and can share that summary with DCEMS to send out in newsletter.

DCEMS Office Updates

Summary of HPCPR metrics has been completed. Dane County EMS agencies continue to demonstrate great patient care for out of hospital cardiac arrests. Agencies continue to meet metrics that were previously set; next steps are to lean forward on post ROSC care and refractory shockable rhythms. CARES outcomes should come some time in May. Will be able to see how the county is doing compared to state and nation. Survivor Celebration is July 24th. R30 is up north getting repaired. Asked the state to put bariatric transports on agenda at the last meetings, but there was not much discussion at that time. R31 is making progress towards being deployable; goal is to have it stocked and approved by state by EMS Week. PulsePoint and CRG mapping collaborated to show CRG maps to PulsePoint users that are Professional Responders. Can be viewed in the PulsePoint app.
