DISCLOSURES AND RECUSALS

Members of the body should make any required disclosures or recusals under the City's Ethics Code.

1. Reconvening of the Municipal Board of Canvass at the behest of the Wisconsin Election Commission to correct actions and decisions as outlined in Part One, Part Two, and Part Three of the Wisconsin Elections Commission - Order Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 5.06(6) as it relates to the "23" absentee ballots counted at City of Madison and Dane County Board of Canvass for the April 7, 2026 Spring Election.

Background was given by City Clerk McComas and ACA McReynolds.

2. Examine the 23 ballots that arrived after 8 pm deadline due to clerk error and were included in the initial certification count by the MBOC.

Ward 75: could not determine which ballots were late delivered, five ballots drawn down per Wisconsin State Statutes.

Ward 77: one ballot marked identified as late delivered, drawn down per Wisconsin State Statutes

Ward 79: could not determine which ballots were late delivered, fifteen ballots drawn down per Wisconsin State Statutes

Ward 132: two ballots marked identified as late delivered, drawn down per Wisconsin State Statutes

3. Adjust the federal, state, local, and school board returns to subtract the votes cast for those offices on the 23 ballots.

Totals adjusted for the state, local, and school board candidates

4. The MBOC is ordered to submit updated canvass statements to the Commission, along with minutes from its reconvened meeting, no later than 24 hours after the adjournment of its meeting.

4. Consideration of appealing the WEC order dated April 30, 2026.
