AUTHORIZING A RECREATIONAL TRAIL EASEMENT WITH THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A BICYCLE PEDESTRIAN TRAIL

Dane County Land & Water Resources-Parks Division (County) and the Wisconsin Department
of Natural Resources (WDNR) have worked together to plan, design and permit a segment of
trail from Waucheeta Trail in the Town of Dunn through Capital Springs Centennial State Park.
The multi-use trail will provide on road bicyclists traveling through the Waubesa Beach
neighborhood an off-road connection to the Lower Yahara River Trail, William G. Lunney Lake
Farm Park and the Capital City State Trail.
The WDNR requires a recreational trail easement to allow the County to construct the new trail

- 14 segment through Capital Springs Centennial State Park. The County recommends accepting
- 15 the terms of the easement including acceptance of \$49,900 in funds from the WDNR.
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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the
 Dane County Executive hereby authorize the acceptance of a recreational trail easement from
 the WDNR for the construction of a public trail through Capital Springs Centennial State Park
 according to Wis. Stats. Chapter 27.03(3); and

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22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Dane County Clerk, Dane County Land & Water

23 Resources Department Director and the Real Estate Coordinator are authorized to administer

the closing and the transfer of the above-mentioned easement to Dane County.
