Resolution #2023 - 13

Authorization to Accept Additional Funds from WI Department of Health Services to Support the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Programs

Public Health Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) proposes the acceptance of additional funding from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) to support the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program.

The Board of Health for Madison and Dane County previously approved Resolution #2023- 08 authorizing the acceptance of \$967,747 from Wisconsin Department of Health Services for WIC services. PHMDC received an additional \$24,808 from WI DHS, increasing the total funding amount to \$989,555.

Furthermore, PHMDC received an additional \$378 from WI DHS for a total of \$10,537 for the Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP).

Lastly, WIC is participating in a Tufts Telehealth Grant, and received \$1,705 from WI DHS. This grant cycle will conclude in April 2023.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County on behalf of Public Health Madison and Dane County authorizes the Director of Public Health, or their designee, to accept and expend the funds in the total amount of \$989,555 for the WIC budget, \$10,537 for the FMNP and \$1,705 for the Tufts Telehealth grant.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that Public Health Madison and Dane County is authorized to adjust the 2023 Public Health Budget accordingly based on the amounts outlined above.
