1. Update on Staff Meetings with Landowners

Staff presented the attached presentation to the commission and shared the latest information from their discussions with the landowners of the six historical sites. Commissioners discussed that they would prefer the Dugout Canoe marker to be located at the overlook or on the boathouse, that they would prefer the Harry Whitehorse marker to be located closer to the driveway of the Whitehorse home/studio, and that they would prefer a rock marker (versus a post marker) at the Ho-Chunk Village site. Staff will follow up with the makers of the signs to verify that the sign prices are still the same as listed on the January 2025 document from the State.
