

**AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF SARE GRANT AWARD TO INVESTIGATE THE
POTENTIAL OF WINTER CAMELINA TO MITIGATE NITROGEN IMMOBILIZATION AND
NITRATE LEACHING AS A COVER CROP**

The Dane County Extension Department has been awarded a grant for \$39,397 by North Central Region Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education (NCR-SARE) Partnership Grant program.

Grant funds will be used to cover costs related to research on whether winter camelina, one of the few cover crops that can overwinter when planted following soybeans in Wisconsin, can help farmers reap the conservation benefits of an overwintering cover crop while avoiding the pitfalls of nitrogen immobilization. There is no match requirement for this grant.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Dane County UW-Extension is authorized to accept the funds and that account EXTENSN NEW "SARE 2025 Grant Revenue" be established with a budget amount of \$39,397 and account EXTENSN NEW "SARE 2025 Grant Expense" be established with a budget amount of \$39,397; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all unexpended funds and unrecognized revenues from this account be carried forward from the 2025 to the 2026 budget period.
