## 2023 Fall Friends Grant Application Summary

The Foundation for Dane County Parks and Dane County Parks collaborative grant program is open to Dane County Parks Friend Groups and partner organizations to lead educational programs, implement small projects, and purchase equipment for volunteer workdays. This collaborative grant program can fund a full or partial project/program between \$250-\$2,000. There was \$13,000 of available funding for the fall 2023 grant cycle, which comes from the Madison Community Foundation's Friends of Dane County Parks Endowment Fund distribution. The fall grant application period ran from September 1, 2023 to October 15, 2023. The Foundation for Dane County Parks Allocations Committee met with Dane County Parks staff on Thursday, November 2, 2023 to review application and make the grant award recommendations as outlined below.
