

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE YAHARA WATERSHED IMPROVEMENT NETWORK SERVICE AGREEMENT

The Yahara Watershed Improvement Network (WINS) is a group of municipalities and point source dischargers that have entered into an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to use Watershed Adaptive Management to meet their regulatory obligations to reduce the amount of phosphorus they contribute to the Yahara River Watershed.

The Dane County Land & Water Resources Department currently provides services to Yahara WINS through an agreement that runs from 2022 – 2025. Both parties wish to extend this agreement through December 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors approves an Amendment to the Service Agreement with the Yahara Watershed Improvement Network.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the County Executive and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Amendment to the Service Agreement.
