1. Dane County Agricultural Conservation Easement Program (ACEP) Pilot

Hicklin gave an brief update on the program status. \$300,000 was established in the 2023 County Budget or provide matching grants of 25% of project costs for agricultural conservation easements. The Land & Water and Planning & Development Departments are working together along with local area experts on program details and standards and expects to release additional information later this year.
