

## Land Conservation Fee Schedule

### Manure Storage Facility Permits

| Permit                                               | Fee     | Notes                                                                                                                             |
|------------------------------------------------------|---------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| <b>Manure Storage Facility</b>                       | \$1,000 | Includes: construction of a new facility, modification of existing facility, transfer systems, leachate/runoff collection systems |
| <b>Manure Storage Facility After the Fact Permit</b> | \$2,000 | Charged if construction occurs without a permit                                                                                   |
| <b>Manure Storage Closure</b>                        | \$0     | No fees if permit is obtained prior to closure                                                                                    |
| <b>Manure Storage Closure After the Fact Permit</b>  | \$1,000 | Charged if closure starts without a permit                                                                                        |
| <b>Certificate of Use</b>                            | \$1,000 | Application can include multiple facilities under one farm                                                                        |

*Note: Cost-share assistance may be available for construction or closure. A cost-share contract shall be signed before work can commence.*

### Winter Spreading Permits

| Permit                                                           | Fee   | Notes                                                                                       |
|------------------------------------------------------------------|-------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| <b>Winter Spreading Permit</b><br>w/SNAP Plus Database           | \$0   | Submit an electronic copy of the SNAP Plus database that includes the winter spreading plan |
| <b>Winter Spreading Permit</b><br>w/out SNAP Plus database       | \$100 | Submit a PDF copy of the Nutrient Management Plan that includes the winter spreading plan   |
| <b>Winter Spreading Permit</b><br>w/out Nutrient Management Plan | \$500 | Staff are available to assist with the development of plan for first time permittees        |

*Note: Cost-share assistance may be available to develop a nutrient management plan. A cost-share contract shall be signed before a plan is developed. Winter spreading permit applications and plan updates are required to be submitted by October 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.*

### Farmland Preservation Program Fees

| Activity                 | Fee                   | Notes                                                          |

| <b>FPP Status Review</b> | \$50 +<br>\$0.50/acre | Fee charged once every four years<br>Effective January 1, 2027 |
