The 8 program is scheduled to close at the end of September 2025. 9 10 The program provided climate-controlled palette shelter to up to 29 households experiencing 11 homelessness, and helped more than 52 households transition into permanent housing with the 12 help of campground service provider Madison Street Medicine, and other community partner 13 agencies. 14 15 The Dane County Board of Supervisors authorized funding to support operations of the camparound in the 2024 and 2025 Dane County budgets. Even though the program is 16 17 scheduled to end, legislative action is still needed to release Dane County's budgeted 2025 18 operations contribution to the City of Madison. 19 20 The Dane County Department of Human Services – Housing Access and Affordability Division 21 (HAA) seeks to award a \$174,500 contract to the City of Madison to support the Dairy Drive 22 urban campground operations.
