E. Reports to Committee

1 2027 LIO Budget

MUELLER reported that the budget files had just come in and he is starting work on them. The LIO is in deficit spending and working with the Budget Office. Recommending the IM take on the Esri licensing costs like it does for Microsoft products. The ROD is yet to meet with the Budget Office on the recorded document revenue projections. VIOLANTE recommended that departments include Esri licensing numbers in each of their department budgets as a contingency for not getting it in the IM budget.

2 City of Madison Data Sharing Issue

VIOLANTE reported the on the status of talks with City of Madison Assessors Office. He provided a brief history of how the City of Madison shared property information with the County. In 2024, the city purchased a new CAMA system and the data transfer broke. Not much progress has been made to date, but efforts continue. VIOLANTE informed the council that the longer this issue continue the greater the impact on a number systems in the county that rely on the City of Madison data being part of the county wide data.

3 Remonumentation/Parcel Mapping Status

FRICK provided a report on the status of the county wide remonumentation project. To date twenty-five of the townships have been remonumented, with two township a year being completed. Following remonumentation the Land Records Division undertakes a comprehensive recompilation of the tax parcel data to the new control.
