ITEMS REMOVED: Communications Surcharge for 911 Systems and Multi-line Telephone System (MLTS) Calls to 911. Recent legislation has created the 911 fund using the surcharge fee and has also created pilot programs for Live 911 and other improvements to EMS response.

POSSIBLE ADDITION/ALTERNATIVE: With uncertainty surrounding FEMA funding, the board may choose to consider language such as “Encourage financial support for local governments to adequately communicate, prevent, prepare, and respond to emergencies.”
