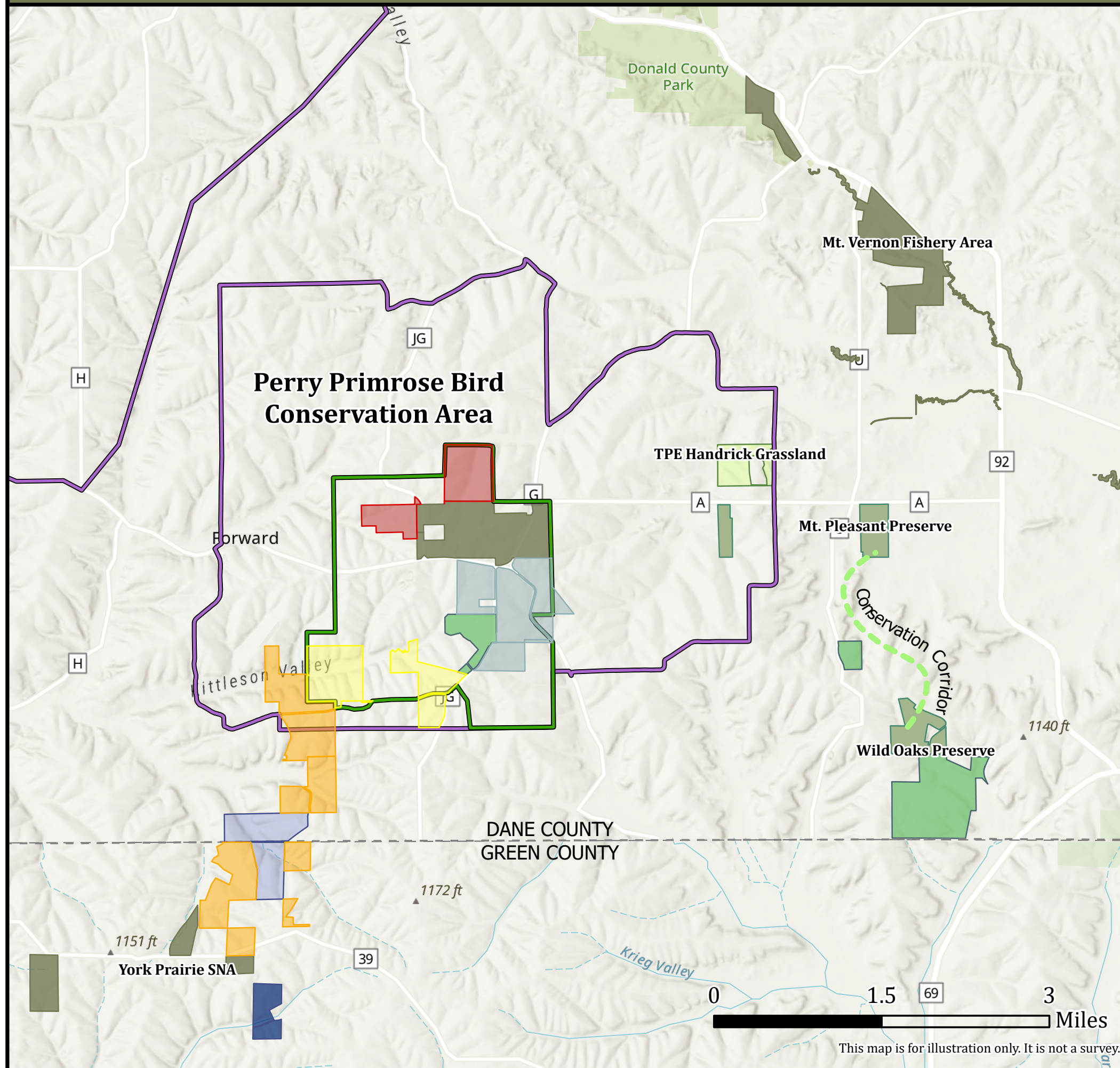

History & Mission

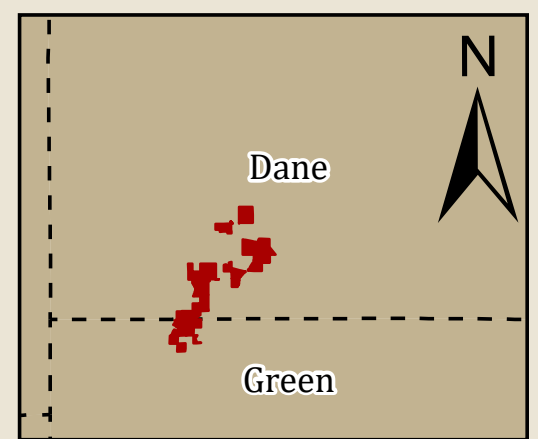
- Work started in 2020; officially incorporated in Sep 2022
 - Mission is “to protect and restore natural habitat for wildlife biodiversity, ecological sustainability, and provide welcoming access for all to enjoy the wonder of nature”
 - Our primary partner is the Driftless Area Land Conservancy (DALC)
 - Also have projects with The Prairie Enthusiasts (TPE), Capital Off Road Pathfinders (CORP)
 - We own 180 acres in the Town of Primrose- hoping to expand over time
 - We are the primary land manager for Wild Oaks, Mt Pleasant, and Dragon Woods (535 acres total)
 - Activities (current & planned) include
 - Savanna, prairie, and wetland restoration
 - Building trails
 - Offering recreational & educational programming (eg. deer hunting program, skills workshops, guided hikes)
 - Supporting agricultural practices that improve soil health and water quality
