#### Goal:

To collaboratively develop a strategic plan for the Dane County CJC that provides a clear roadmap for the council, including its staff and subcommittees, for the next three years.

	Behavioral Health & Substance Use	Pretrial Alternatives
System Lens	Focuses on service gaps and interventions for people with behavioral health needs regardless of legal status	Focuses on how cases are handled in the early stages of the legal process regardless of behavioral health status
Core Charge	Improve the behavioral health continuum and reduce justice system involvement caused by unmet treatment needs	Improve front-end case handling through diversion, screening, and release alternatives
Possible Strategies	<ul> <li>Strengthening crisis management and coordination</li> <li>Advancing the development of a crisis triage center plan</li> <li>Reducing barriers to housing for justice involved individuals</li> <li>Creating a data repository to improve delivery of community-centered care</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Expanding eligibility for pre-charge or post-charge diversion</li> <li>Enhancing pretrial risk screening tools and early decision-making</li> <li>Streamlining case processing for low-level charges</li> <li>Using restorative practices or court alternatives</li> </ul>

#### Create a community justice center

Discontinue "stacking" of criminal charges

Expedite early appointment of counsel

Implement weekend initial appearance court

Assess COVID-era practices (e.g., use of summons, dismissals, etc.)

Strengthen pretrial services/modify decision-making framework

Expand access to interpreters

Improve consistency in judicial practices
