

46 (b) It shall be illegal to sell or deliver any cannabinoid product to a person
47 without having first verified their age by having the purchaser present a
48 valid federal, state or municipal issued photo identification. This age
49 verification must be done by a person and may not be automated.

50 (c) Signs and notices.

51 1. A person, business, retailer, or entity engaged in the sale of
52 cannabinoid products must post a sign in areas within their
53 premises where any cannabinoid product is sold to consumers
54 stating that the sale of any such to any person under the age of
55 twenty-one (21) is unlawful under this section.

57 **(3) PENALTIES.**

58 (a) Any person, business, retailer, or entity who violates any provision
59 34.236(2)(a) or 34.236(2)(c)1. shall, upon conviction, be subject to a
60 forfeiture of not less than \$400, nor more than \$1000, exclusive of
61 costs, and upon failure to pay the same may be confined in the
62 county jail for not more than thirty days.

63 (b) Each day a violation of section 34.236(2)(d)1. exists constitutes a
64 separate violation of this ordinance.

65 (c) Repeated violations of this section constitute a public nuisance.
66 Corporation Counsel is authorized to seek any injunction required to
67 abate the nuisance.

68 (d) This ordinance will supersede any ordinance in conflict therewith and
69 must take effect upon passage and publication, as required by law.

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71 *[EXPLANATION: This amendment updates Chapter 34 to restrict the sale of*
72 *cannabinoid products to persons of at least 21 years of age. It requires retailers*
73 *to take certain steps to verify that their customers have reached 21 years of age*
74 *before selling any cannabinoid products. This amendment updates Chapter 2 to*
75 *provide the director of Public Health Madison and Dane County with the*
76 *authority to issue citations for violations of the new provisions.]*
