Intent/Justification

The Immigration Affairs Office (IAO) was established in 2017 in response to a growing immigrant community presenting with complex situations and language needs beyond what the Department could serve within existing resources. IAO filled a service gap to support families and connect them with allowable and available resources, thereby preventing more dire situations from emerging. Eliminating this position will decrease capacity to respond to critical community needs.

There's approximately \$74,000 remaining in offset from PPJ O 2 which eliminates vacant deputy positions and there is approximately \$45,000 remaining in offset from PWT O-1 after funding the LWR Parks Div Volunteer Coordinator (the primary recipient of offset from PWT O-1)
