
FSET FoodShare Employment and Training

- Available to any adult (age 16+) who receives FoodShare
- DCDHS contracts with Forward Service Corporation to provide FSET
- Specialized Programs
 - Big Step (WRTP)
 - CommonWealth Development
 - Family Stabilization
 - Just Bakery
 - Omega School (Literacy Network)
 - Operation Fresh Start
 - ReEntry (JustDane)
 - Urban League
 - YWeb (YWCA)

W2 (Wisconsin Works)

- Wisconsin's TANF program
- Designed for Parents (not caretakers)
- Goal is employment
- Stipends available for participation
- Participants may be eligible for Wisconsin Shares
 (child care subsidy)
- Similar services to FSET, but more requirements to join

- Job Readiness- lots of things
- **■** Employment Search
- Training
- Supportive Services
- **■** Job Retention

FSET Rules

- Work Requirements
 - Ages 18-54-64
 - No children **under 14** in household and not a primary caretaker
 - "Able-Bodied"
- Homelessness is generally an **exemption** from Work Requirements
 - But we SERVE anyone on FoodShare who wants it
- ► FSET is "voluntary"
