60 million state specific broadband expansion funding made available through PSC. Eligible applicants include an organization, a telecommunications utility, or a political subdivision of the State (city, village, town, or county) that has established a legal partnership or joint venture arrangement with an otherwise qualified organization or telecommunications utility; and as such meets the eligibility requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. § 196.504(1).

Grant opens May 19, 2026 and closes July 27, 2026 at 1:30 p.m. CST
