E. Presentations

 Black Earth Creek restoration project at Walking Iron County Park / Mazomanie Lions Park

James Brodzeller, Watershed Management Coordinator for the Land and Water Resources Department provided an overview of planning that has been completed by Fish Creek Restoration consultants to date for the proposed Black Earth Creek stream restoration project. The project includes approximately 4,000' of Black Earth Creek between the southern border of Walking Iron County Park and the Village of Mazomanie. Major goals of the project include improving water quality, floodplain connectivity, fish and wildlife habitat, carbon sequestration and enhancing public use of the corridor. Stream restoration improvements proposed include realigning the channel to historic locations, riparian wetland and prairie restoration, a variety of natural bank stabilization and habitat improvement practices and re-establishing stream connections to the floodplain during high water conditions. Planning is anticipated to be completed in late 2023, and construction in 2024 pending approval of funding in the Dane County capital budget.

2. Door Creek restoration project at Door Creek Wildlife Area South Unit

James Brodzeller and Dane County Land and Water Resources Watersheds Division staff have been working on plans to remove sediment and re-align Door Creek to its original alignment in the Door Creek Wildlife Area South Unit. The project is a recommendation of the Door Creek Watershed Management Action Plan and includes approximately 11,000' stream restoration work between CTH MN and Lake Kegonsa. Goals for the project include re-establishing a riverine environment, improving pike spawning habitat, increasing connectivity to the floodplain, improving water quality and enhancement of surrounding wetlands.

F. Reports to Committee

1. Black Earth Creek Headwaters property stabilization update

Alex DeSmidt, Senior Landscape Architect, Dane County Parks Division and Brodzeller outlined restoration and property stabilization measures that have recently been completed on the Dane County Black Earth Creek Headwaters natural resource area property. Restoration projects include creation of waterfowl scrapes and prairie restorations adjacent to the existing Old Lake Middleton water body. Property stabilization efforts include removal of existing buildings at the original farmstead site and a proposed public parking lot at the existing STH 14 driveway entrance.
