Each block contains eight 4'x8' possible burial lots. Half blocks contain four 4'x8' possible burial lots. The blocks will be designated as orienting in a north-south or east-west direction with each burial lot identified with a letter from a-h in full blocks and a-d in half blocks. The actual number and orientation of burial lots used in a given block or half block depend on factors such as, but not limited to, physical terrain (presence of bedrock, trees, etc.), cultural practice and personal preference.

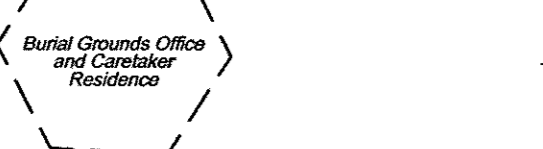
