AUTHORIZING HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDING FOR A SPEED ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE PROJECT

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin, is making funding of \$105,000 available for participation in a 2025/2026 Speed Enforcement Task Force Project, Grant Number SPD-2026-DANE CO SO-00124; grant project period is October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026.

Current Policy or Practice -

Acceptance of grant funding requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Excessive speed is often associated with high-risk behaviors that increase the likelihood of a crash and of significant injury or death occurring; these include following too closely and failure to wear seat belts. In 2024, 170 people were killed and 6,567 were injured in speed-related crashes in Wisconsin. This resulted in an average of one person being killed or injured every 1.3 hours due to speeding.
