Deflections/Diversions

- What is the difference?
- Diversion is a criminal justice term for policies and practices related to those individuals who have already entered the justice system. In deflection, inclusive of the term prearrest diversion, a person does not move into the justice system beyond the initial contact with police.

National changes-May 2022

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today, the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) announced the release of the Model Law Enforcement and Other First Responders Deflection Act, a resource for states that encourages the development and use of deflection programs across the country. These programs are needed because first responders, including law enforcement, often do not have good options when encountering people with substance use and/or mental health disorders. In a growing number of states, public safety and public health partnerships "deflect" people with these disorders away from traditional criminal justice programs and connect them to evidence-based treatment, harm reduction, recovery and prevention services.





