3	ESTABLISHING AN EQUITY FOOD PROGRAM FOR 2023
4	
5	In the 2023 budget, the Dane County Board of Supervisors appropriated funding to encourage
6	the innovative developments of projects that advance equity and access in local food systems in
7 8	Dane County. To better assess the viability of potential projects, the Office for Equity and Inclusion ("OEI") oversaw a grant process that invited individuals and organizations to identify
8 9	and explain how their proposals would meet the needs of the community.
10	
11	At the conclusion of the application review process, OEI identified the following class of
12	individuals who could be helped by providing a service as part of a food equity program:
13	low-income neighborhoods that have increased food demands and are in need of
14	expanded food assistance, access and security to families, children, teens, senior
15	citizens, historically underserved populations and individuals at risk of hunger in several
16	Dane County communities; low-income and under-employed Dane County communities
17	including but not limited to Cottage Grove, DeForest, Sun Prairie, Oregon, Madison,
18	Middleton, Fitchburg, Verona, and Windsor. Communities that are in need of food for
19	specific dietary needs, such as items that are Gluten Free, Nut Free, Dairy Free, Egg
20	Free, culturally diets like kosher items, beans, rice, soy, etc. Food equity programs to
21	assist the immediate provision for fresh garden produce, that incorporates local food
22	into the school lunch menu that simultaneously supports local farmer and expose students
23	to a variety of produce they may not have access to at home. Food equity programs to help
24	promote healthy habits, develop and teach educational demonstrations of growing,
25	harvesting and cooking using indigenous farming techniques. Food programs that provide
26	culturally appropriate foods and nutritionally balanced meals to seniors, children and
27	adults.

29	NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Dane County Board of Supervisors does hereby
30	establish an equity food program for 2023, as a program for relief that will serve the specific
31	class of persons identified in lines 12 to 27 of this Resolution;
32 33	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office for Equity and Inclusion is hereby authorized to
33 34	operate the 2023 Equity Food Program, and to secure the provision of services for the classes of
35	persons previously identified
