Brief Description of Proposal -

OECC partnered with HVAC industry partners to host a half-day training session on heat pump adoption in Dane County. The HVAC industry partners provided financial support to cover food and facility costs associated with the event. That support totals \$5,000 and covers all food, beverage and facility costs for the 100+ attendees.

Current Policy or Practice -

Fund to be approved through County Board.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

This public-private partnership is being hailed as a model for other regions across the Midwest. Already we see evidence that attending contractors are planning to offer more heat pumps to Dane County households, which is exactly our goal.
