AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING SALVAGE OPERATIONS

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Ordinance amendment restores salvage operations as a condition use allowed in the Industrial Zoning District. It also aligns definitions of salvage with those used for State licensing and regulation. This amendment also removes a obsolete County salvage licensing requirement.

Current Policy or Practice -

Only salvage recycling centers are allowed in the Industrial District leaving it difficult to site small salvage operations.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

A conditional use permit will be available for small salvage opertions to be located in areas with compatible land uses.
