

Dane County Comprehensive Plan

- Chapter 82, Dane County Code
 - Dane County Comprehensive Plan (2007, 2015)
 - ▶ Volume I: Goals, Policies and Objectives
 - ▶ Issues and opportunites, Housing, Economic Development, Community Facilities, Agricultural, Natural and Cultural Resources, Transportation, Intergovernmental Cooperation, Land Use and Implementation
 - ▶ Volume II: Issues and Opportunities and Background Data
 - Dane County Farmland Preservation Plan (2022)
 - ▶ Individual Town Comprehensive Plans
 - Adopted by County Board (for towns under county zoning)
 - Automatically adopted (for towns under town zoning)
 - City and Village Plans (automatically adopted under state statute)

Dane County Zoning


- ► Chapter 10, Dane County Code
 - Controls use of land
 - Comprehensively rewritten in 2019
 - Adopted by 25 towns
 - Rudimentary Historic Preservation Overlay district (limited usage, protects only burial sites)
- Section 59.69, Wisconsin Statutes
 - County board and majority of town boards must approve any zoning ordinance amendments
 - County board and affected town board must approve all rezone petitions (map amendments)
 - ► Specific allowances for historic preservation

Urban Service Areas



Dane County Farmland Preservation Plan

- Chapter 82, Dane County Code
 - ► Makes farmers eligible for farmland preservation income tax credits
 - ► Comprehensively rewritten in 2022
 - ▶ Applies in 29 towns, 2 villages, 1 city and 3 extraterritorial jurisdictions
 - Requires nonfarm density caps, siting criteria and FP zoning to preserve farmland
- Chapter 91, Wisconsin Statutes
 - ▶ Farmers can qualify for tax credit of \$7.50 / acre / year
 - Land uses limited in Farmland Preservation Area
 - ▶ Requires compliance with county soil and water conservation standards

Environmental Regulations



Dane County Environmental Regulations

- Shoreland / Wetland Zoning (Chapter 11, Dane County Code)
 - ▶ Applies within 1000' of lakes, 300' of rivers/streams in all towns
 - Applies to all wetlands in all towns
 - Prohibits most development within 75' of ordinary high water mark or wetland boundary
 - Sets impervious surface limits
- Floodplain Zoning (Chapter 17, Dane County Code)
 - ► Applies in 1% floodplains of all towns
 - ► Limits development in floodfringe
 - Prohibits development in floodway
- Both make allowances for nonconforming buildings

Permitting related to buildings and development

- County only
 - Zoning permits
 - Shoreland / Wetland / Floodplain permits
 - Erosion Control and Stormwater permits
 - Agricultural Conservation compliance
 - Sanitary permits
 - County Highway access
- County and town
 - Rezones and conditional use permits
 - ▶ Land divisions
- ► Town only
 - Building permits
 - Driveway permits
