1 2022 RES-346 2 3 ACCEPTANCE OF WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES 4 GRANTS TO REPLACE SNOWMOBILE TRAIL BRIDGE & CROSSING 5 6 The Land & Water Resources Department – Parks Division has secured two \$83,000 Outdoor 7 Recreation Aids grant in the total amount of \$166,000 from the Wisconsin Department of 8 Natural Resources (WDNR) for two snowmobile trail bridges. 9 10 One grant will replace a deteriorating snowmobile bridge on State Corridor #38 in the Town of Pleasant Springs. The existing bridge is known as the Dane VSD2 Leutten Creek Skaalen 11 12 Farms Bridge #28. The current bridge is of unknown age and load capacity. 13 The second grant will replace culverts on State Corridor #38 in the Town of Pleasant Springs. 14 Current culverts are of unknown age. Culverts and previously abandoned & unusable 15 snowmobile bridge will be removed and replaced with new bridge. The new bridge will be known 16 as the Dane VSD 3 Leutten Creek Rein Farm Bridge #29. 17 18 19 Both new bridges will conform to all state waterway regulations and load requirements. 20 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the grant in the amount of \$166,000 from the WDNR; 22 23 and 24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account CPLWRESC 81623 Snowmobile Trail 25 Bridge Grant shall be increased by \$166,000. Two new expenditure accounts "Snowmobile 26 27 Bridge #28 Leutten Creek" and "Snowmobile Bridge #29 Leutten Creek" shall each be 28 established for \$83,000. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
