18 19 20 21	ARTICLE 3. Section 7.22(5)(a) is amended to read as follows: <b>(5)</b> Open meetings shall be held in public buildings or other places, including virtual venues, accessible to the general public, including individuals with disabilities.
22 23 24 25 26	(a)-Board and committee members are expected to attend meetings in person, unless a member cannot physically attend due to safety concerns, unforeseen circumstances, health reasons or the care of family members with health conditions.: a member must notify the chair prior to an in-person or hybrid meeting for an exception to attend virtually.
27 28 29 30	ARTICLE 4. Section 7.22(5)(c) is created to read as follows:  (c) Prior to each meeting, all members shall receive a hyperlink that will permit them to attend virtually.
31 32 33 34	ARTICLE 5. Section 7.22(5)(d) is created to read as follows:  (d) A member's virtual attendance shall not be noted on agendas or meeting minutes.
