CREATING NEW REVENUE LINE IN DCDHS BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DIVISION

Since 2017 the Dane County Department of Human Services (DCDHS) has partnered with the Madison Police Department to provide the Madison Area Addiction Recovery Initiative (MAARI), a pre-arrest deflection program that provides the option of treatment in lieu of an arrest and incarceration. Through 2023, this has been funded through a grant from the federal Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance. This grant has also funded Addiction Resource Team, which pairs a Madison Police Officer with a Peer Specialist/Recovery Coach to follow-up with people who have lived through an overdose to connect them with recovery-based resources. It was expected that this grant would end in 2023 until a no-cost extension of the grant was unexpectedly granted at the end of the year. These additional funds are available through September 30, 2024.

DCDHS will use these funds to continue its contract with Safe Community Coalition of Madison and Dane County to provide Peer Specialist/Recovery Coaches to both MAARI and the Addiction Recovery Team.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following revenue account be added in the Department of Human Services and that the revenue be credited to the County General Fund and transferred from the General Fund to the following expenditure account in the Department of Human Services:
