Isolation/Quarantine Center (IQC)

- ▶ Daily Average: 7 guests
- ▶ Feb high: 12 (02/23/23)
 - ▶ March 11, April 14, May 46, June 39, July 57, Aug 38, Sept 33, Oct 18, Nov 30, Dec 1, Jan 20
- ▶ Feb low: 4 (02/20/23)
 - ▶ March 7, April 7, May 4, June 16, July 20, Aug 5, Sept 3, Oct 2, Nov 3, Dec 26, Jan 6



Hotels to Housing (H2H)

- ▶ As of Feb 28th, 2022
 - ❑ 230 total households enrolled currently
 - 197 currently housed: 107 LSS, 50 The Salvation Army (TSA) & 40 (EQUUS)
 - 33 enrolled & searching for housing (23 singles & 10 families)
 - ❖ *Majority of slots to be enrolled yet are for TSA families*
 - ❑ 257 Total housed to date
 - 39 housed exits for various reasons (voucher, deceased, assisted living, etc.)
 - 33 have been non-renewed/asked to leave (average of 13.6%):
 - ❖ *17 rehoused, 13 have left & are searching, & 3 exits*

NOTE: Goal was for program to serve a total of 297 households. To date, H2H has served a total 326 households including 52 households enrolled (did not find housing) and exited due to various reasons. Placement into housing is an average of 78.8%.



CORE 2.0

- ▶ Since Sept 2021, CORE has served 9,221 households for a total of \$61,466,919 in rent and utilities to date.
- ▶ Portal is still open and agencies are still processing applications

Doubled Up Households RFP

RFP outlines a desire to partner with provider agencies in the community to serve households with minor children who are experiencing Doubled Up Homelessness which includes households that are self-paying in hotels and motels. The funding supports case management and direct assistance for up to 12 months of full financial support of rent, utilities, and limited relocation costs such as security deposits, and application fees.
