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AWARDING A CONTRACT TO SOLACE FRIENDS, INC. FOR END OF LIFE HOUSING FOR UNHOUSED PERSONS DCDHS – HAA DIVISION

The Dane County Department of Human Services – Housing Access and Affordability Division
(HAA) seeks to contract with Solace Friends, Inc. to administer an end of life shelter program for
individuals experiencing homelessness in need of end of life care.

As part of the Dane County Executive's 2024 budget, \$100,000 in GPR was authorized to
provide shelter and support services, administered by Solace Friends, Inc., for up to 4 unhoused
individuals with a terminal illness. The contract term will be January 1, 2024 to December 31,
2024.

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16 The most recent Dane County Continuum of Care data indicates there were 49 deaths of people 17 experiencing homelessness in the most recent 18 month period. Local shelters are operating at

18 historic capacities and hospitals are struggling to discharge patients who are housing insecure

19 to appropriate post-acute care. In January, Dane County's emergency shelters serving single

adult men reached historic levels averaging 291 guests an evening and peaking at 347 guests.
 Additionally, Dane County's emergency shelter serving single adult women has been peaking at

22 80 guests during the winter months.

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Households enrolled in the adult family home with Solace Friends, Inc. will be eligible for

services that include shelter in the 4 bedroom adult family home, medical support, end of life

care, case management, connection to resources and basic needs while enrolled in hospice

27 care. Solace anticipates serving up to 20 individuals annually.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a \$100,000 contract be approved for
 Solace Friends, Inc. (term of January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024) and that the County
 Executive and County Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign the agreement on behalf
