This letter acknowledges the commitment of \$124,250 by the Ice Age Trail Alliance to Dane County in support of the Dane County Parks restoration and land management program. These funds are derived from a National Fish and Wildlife Foundation grant.

Dane County's portion of the grant will be spent as follows:

- \$107,309 to hire Dane County Parks LTE Land Restoration & Land Management Specialists
- \$16,941 to purchase prairie seed

Payment will be made by the Ice Age Trail Alliance upon completion of the following terms:

- The restoration projects will restore and improve pollinator habitat for the monarch butterfly, Karner blue butterfly, rusty patched bumble bee, regal fritillary, and other pollinators on Dane County Parkland.
- Dane County Parks will provide 300 pounds of seed to Dane County Land Conservation to be used for the Continuous Cover Program. The seed will include a minimum of 20 different native forb species that are known to provide pollinator habitat.
- Invoices and associated supporting documentation must be received by the Ice Age Trail Alliance guarterly with the final request no later than November 13, 2023.
