Brief Description of Proposal -

This ordinance amendment would allow the County Executive to authorize lodging expenses for certain county employees in the event of severe weather or a natural disaster.

Current Policy or Practice -

Under current ordinances, lodging for employees in Dane County is not an authorized expense.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Under this amendment to the ordinances, the County Executive could authorize lodging expenses for certain employees. For instance, plow divers or 911 workers who put in extra shifts during an emergency could get lodging to between shifts.
