6 7	The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:
8 9 10	ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.
10 11 12	ARTICLE 2. Section 2.06(262d) is created to read as follows: 2.06 SCHEDULE OF DEPOSITS
13 14 15	(262d) 47.17(2m) Failure to comply with animal restrictions following an attack, bite, or injury - \$500.00
16 17	ARTICLE 3. Section 47.17 is amended to read as follows: 47.17 OWNER OR CUSTODIANS TO CONROL ANIMALS.
18 19 20	(2) When an animal is off the property of its owner or custodian, the owner or custodian shall not permit, whether negligently or otherwise, the animal to attack, bits or otherwise injure:
21	bite or otherwise injure: (a) any other domestic animal;
22	(b) any person who is engaged in a lawful activity.
23 24	(2m) Any person who owns or is the custodian of an animal that violates Sub. (2) shall immediately comply with the following:
25	(a) The animal while off the property where kept, shall be muzzled and
26	leashed at all times. The muzzle must be made in a manner that will not cause
27	injury to the animal but that will prevent it from biting any person or animal. The
28	leash shall be attached to a secure collar that is of sufficient strength to restrain
29	the animal. The leash shall be no longer than four (4) feet in length total and
30 31	must be secured by and under the direct control and supervision of a competent adult;
32	(b) When outside but still on the property of the owner or caretaker, the animal
33	must be supervised by a competent adult and physically restrained at all times to
34	prevent the animal from leaving the property. An electronic fence or an electronic
35	collar are not considered to be a physical restraint. If the department determines
36	that the animal may be kept in a secure kennel or pen, hereinafter referred to as
37	<u>"structure"</u> , and not under the direct supervision of an adult, the department may
38	require that the structure be constructed under some or all of the following
39 40	<u>quidelines:</u>The structure shall be constructed of strong metal fencing to prevent the
41	animal from exiting on its own volition;
42	2. The structure shall be secure on all sides and have a secure top attached;
43	3. The structure shall have a secure bottom or floor attached to the sides of
44	the structure or the sides of the structure shall be embedded in the ground no
45	less than two (2) feet;

- 46 <u>4. The structure shall be kept locked at all times with a key or combination lock;</u>
- 48 <u>5. The structure shall provide adequate light, ventilation and shelter from the environment for the animal;</u>
- 50 **6.** The structure shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition;
- 51 **7.** The structure must be in compliance with all other building and zoning ordinances.

- 54 ARTICLE 4. Section 47.51 is created to read as follows:
- 55 **47.51 PENALTIES.**
- 56 **(8n)** Any person who violates section 47.17(3) of this ordinance shall forfeit not more than \$500.
