#### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

Public Health Madison and Dane County proposes accepting Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) "Strengthening U.S. Public Health Infrastructure, Workforce, and Data Systems" funding in the amount of \$1,237,990 with a funding period of 12/1/2022 - 11/30/2027.

## Current Policy or Practice -

The Intergovernmental Agreement creating the joint City-County health department requires approval of both the Dane County Board and the City Council for a new grant of over \$50,000.

### Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Funding will be applied to extend three existing and staffed project positions through the end of the funding period, keeping key personnel capacity in the department to address gaps.
