Move to Amend Sub. 1 as amended by PP&J by inserting at line 305:

4. Using the conclusions of the 3 work groups, Mead and Hunt shall propose capital projects that can be done in the short term to: address health and safety issues, comply with the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) Standards, create special needs beds, adaptations of current facilities to meet immediate mental health needs, develop programming and recreational space within PSC, and phase out the use of the Ferris Center.

Mead and Hunt shall also report those solutions to longer term needs which are recommended both by the Needs Assessment and Master Plan and by at least one of the 3 work groups. Such long term proposals shall optimize programmatic treatment and behavior management resources, contribute to the reduction or elimination of racial disparities, reduce jail population, improve facilities, and address the needs of inmates.
