AUTHORIZING PARC & RIDE GRANT AWARDS

5 The 2023 Land and Water Resources Capital Budget included funds for matching grants to 6 municipalities or 501 (3)(c) non-profit organizations for developing regional bicycle/pedestrian 7 trails or bicycle playgrounds. The PARC & Ride grants are intended to match local dollars and are 8 sponsored by local units of government. The proposed grant awards total \$402,500 in County 9 funds for the following two eligible projects:

12 The PARC & Ride grant awards are contingent on the County and project sponsor entering into a

13 grant agreement that will specify the program requirements and applicable grant conditions for

14 each project. Project sponsors may charge user fees for bicycle facilities, however all residents of

15 Dane County must be charged equally.16

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the PARC & Ride grants are approved by the Dane
County Board and the Dane County Executive. The County will pay up to the grant amount based
on 50% of actual project expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dane County Clerk and Dane County Executive are authorized to execute documents necessary to effectuate the grant awards, which may include grant agreements and management agreements.
